The Cambridge Public School System should explain in detail why CPS is so heavily staffed with administrators and supervisors when compared to all other Massachusetts school districts. Excess administrative positions should be replaced by more teaching professionals in our classrooms.

AS A MARINE CORPS OFFICER, CRAIG LEARNED TO LEAD BY EXAMPLE.

HE'LL TAKE THAT TRAIT TO CITY COUNCIL WITH THE FOLLOWING SUGGESTIONS:

- City Council's Monday night dinners should be the same food our Public School students eat, not specially catered by local delis. The result of such high profile attention would be tastier, healthier school meals, something that is especially important for our more at-risk students.
- Eliminate Council-only parking spots behind City Hall. Councilors might make wiser development decisions if they faced the same traffic and parking constraints we face.
- Councilors should listen more closely to residents' concerns during public meetings, especially during the Council's Public Comment session.
- Councilors should only hold one elected office at a time to avoid conflicting priorities.
